Green Lake Bible Camp Annual Meeting Report

I attended the annual meeting at the camp on February 13, 2024. The past few years have been inspiring as the board of directors and executive director, Travis Aufderheide, have a vision for improving the camp properties and their vision is becoming reality. The capital campaign's project for The Shores of St. Andrew is completed with renovations to the bathrooms, sleeping rooms, the addition of air conditioning and other improvements to improve function and accessibility. In the near future, updates will be coming to the Chrysalis House, on the main campus.

Green Lake Lutheran Ministries provides so many opportunities for people of all ages. The Education Committee here at Faith was excited to have several of our youth attend camp last summer and hope that number will grow. The camp offers a short week for younger kids (\$355) and several full week options (\$695). "Serve Boldly" is an opportunity similar to the Jesus Trips that Pastor Kirk use to plan. Green Lake Lutheran Ministries administer the program but the sites are Duluth, Nashville, St. Louis, or Milwaukee - Racine - or Madison, Wisconsin.

Green Lake Lutheran Ministries also has cabins that they rent out year-round for family reunions or other gatherings.
