COUNCIL REPORT

The Faith Lutheran Church Council met Sunday, March 14, 2021.

Pastor Ron reported that he has held Holy Communion class for the 6th graders and will hold a class soon for the 5th graders.

With the new relaxing of COVID restrictions, there is no capacity limit for worship services. However, social distancing is still in effect as is the requirement to wear masks. The church will be able to hold more people for its Easter Sunday 7 a.m. and 10 a.m. services, but every other pew will still remain empty. Fellowship Hall can be used for overflow if needed.

There have been many questions on when Faith Lutheran Church can begin coffee hour. Unfortunately, Countryside Public Health and other restrictions will not yet allow that to happen. When that is able to happen, it is hoped that there can be a meet and greet with Pastor Ron and his family.

Pastor Ron also discussed the issue of calling a pastor for Faith Lutheran. The paperwork is being updated, though there are not many changes that will need to be made. He will meet with the past call committee to see how many of them are interested in being on the call committee and suggests also bringing on new members for the call committee going forward. He will check with the Synod on this process and see if having the congregation vote on the call committee is recommended.

Because of COVID closing the church last fall, raise reviews were not done. The personnel committee completed performance reviews with Linda Anderson and Jessica Borstad and recommended 2% raises for each of them. Linda's will be retroactive to January 1^{st} , with Jessica's taking effect March 1^{st} as that is her one-year anniversary.

There was no further action on finalizing the church constitution. It is currently with the Synod after having been approved by the Council and is just waiting their final work.

There were questions last month regarding shoveling the sidewalks at church, particularly when Dave Amundson is not available. Dan Wahl is a backup and Todd Mortenson has been added as an additional backup person to ensure that those get done.

There are a couple of issues with both the men's and women's bathrooms that need to be addressed. Mark Siegert and Ryan Giles will follow up to ensure those get taken care of.

A couple of years ago the Lay Ministry Board was disbanded and folded into Global Missions. L That Board has been resurrected, but will be called the Discipleship Board. The members are currently learning their roles and are hoping to hold a new members Sunday soon.

The church is still in need of an Education Director. It was suggested that two people might want to work together as co-directors.

Faith Lutheran Church had applied for COVID relief funds, but is ineligible. However, Little Blessings would be eligible and so that is currently being worked on.

Carlyle Larsen has resigned from the Cemetery Board. Paul Zahrbock has joined the board and will be its treasurer.

The full minutes of the meeting are posted on the bulletin board across from the office and copies are available in the Church office.

Sausage & Squash

- 2 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 Large onion diced
- 2 Tbsp garlic minced
- 1 Beef sausage cut in 1/4 inch pieces
- 1 Andouille sausage cut in 1/4 inch pieces
- 1 Polish sausage cut in 1/4 inch pieces
- 2 cups grape or cherry tomatoes sliced in half lengthwise
- 4 medium zucchini cut in 1/4 inch pieces
- 4 yellow squash cut in 1/4 inch pieces
- 1/2 cup grated parmesan cheese

- Heat oil in a large pot with tall sides
- · Sauté onions and add garlic
- Brown the sausage slices
- Add the tomatoes and work them to the bottom
- Add the zucchini & squash and cook until it is tender
- Mix in the parmesan cheese until melted
- Serve plain or over pasta or rice.


