"RAB-BÓNI"

Jesus said to her, "Mary." She turned and said to him in Hebrew, Rab-bo'ni" (which means Teacher) (John 20:16)

Throughout the course of our Lenten journey to Jerusalem, we focused on the ministry of Jesus as Healer. Holy Week and especially Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter invite our attention to Jesus as Teacher - "Rabbi" in Greek.

What did Jesus teach? When one of Jesus' followers asked which of the Ten Commandments Jesus believed was the most important, Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it: "Love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:36-39)

Such love, "agape" is selfless, unconditional, universal, sacrificial love, The Highest Form of Intimacy. Agape was and is the basis of Jesus' teaching revealed in the mandate on Maundy Thursday and in the humble service of Jesus washing the feet of his disciples as they celebrated the Passover feast; the mandate to love God by loving one another and all of creation as a reflection of God's love for us.

During the Easter season, I invite you to explore with me the what, how and why of Jesus' ministry as our Teacher, our Rabbi. We shall explore the Commandment and mandate to love as the foundation of our shared ministry revealed in Scripture and the historic and apostolic teaching ministry of the Church. It is my hope and prayer that such exploration, sharing and teaching will guide us as we continue to address the need for the healing of the earth, world, nations and relationships facing us in these difficult and challenging times.

May God guide us in teaching the love made incarnate in Jesus, our Rabbi.
