Global Missions Committee would like to say a humble thank you to the Endowment Committee and to Faith members for your gifts to our ELCA World Hunger drive. A total of \$17,614.35 was collected over the Thanksgiving season! Why is someone unable to GET food" Are they ill? Do they lack skills to work towards affording food? Please keep this in mind as you read the list of the many items purchased with our donations. All of these items were purchased through the ELCA Good Gifts catalog so are extremely affordable. Here goes! 2 family farms (all the farm animals needed for the farm) for \$1430, 2 vegetable gardens and honey bees for \$440, 2 simple water wells to serve over 500 families each for \$5000, 10 water filter systems for \$300, 2 irrigation projects for \$200, 2 latrines for \$300, 2 computers for the community center for \$1600, 2 environmentally friendly cookstoves for \$210, 4 farmers field school for women for \$300, 2 microloans for women for \$250, 2 school fees and uniforms for girls for \$80, classroom supplies for 2 whole classrooms for \$600, 2 community vegetable gardens for \$400, mosquito nets for 10 families for \$200, stocked a health clinic for 4 weeks for \$300, a clinic visit for a child for \$10, nutrition for 2 children FOR A YEAR for \$600, feed 2 refugee families for a MONTH for \$400, 1 month of trauma counseling for \$640, 10 warm blankets for \$100, 2 motorbikes for pastors to even GET to their parishes for \$750, 1 semester of tuition for a seminary student for \$2500, feeding 50 at 5 soup kitchens for \$500. 
