"Asking for Too Much"

In the Gospel of Matthew, chapter 14, reveals the story of Jesus multiplying five loaves of bread and two fish to feed over 5000 people. A short summary goes like this: Jesus is teaching a massive crowd of people. The disciples realize it's getting late. They are most likely tired and hungry themselves. Maybe even Jesus needs a break and should send the people to town for supper. They say to Jesus, "... send the crowds away, so they may go to the villages and buy food for themselves." Jesus' surprising reply is "They need not go away you give them something to eat."

Why do you suppose Jesus asks the disciples to do something that they clearly were incapable of doing? The food they had was merely lunch for one or perhaps two. It was not enough. Anyone could see that.

We might ask a similar question. Why does God ask of us more of what we are capable of giving? For that matter, why does our church, community, and family ask more of us than what we can muster? Are not there times when we feel overwhelmed with the demands of the day?

And what about our faith? Jesus calls us to love even our enemies. He asks us share the gospel even when we might be rejected. We might think "Too much! I just don't have what it takes."

The sad thing is that we are exactly right! Jesus does ask of us more than what we have of time, talent, and possession. We simply do not have enough to get the job done. However, there is good news.

While Jesus asks of us more than what we have, he simply is not expecting us to do this on our own. The disciples gave Jesus all they had and Jesus then made it adequate. This is how it works.

Jesus always invites himself to assist us in any endeavor. We give him what we have and he then makes it adequate. Notice the disciples gave Jesus all they had as little as it was, but Jesus then blessed it and shared it with others. It was enough, and more than enough.

Does Jesus ask of us more than we are capable of giving? Oh my, yes! This is so because we are never left unassisted and reliant only upon our own devices. We give all we have to Jesus and he makes it enough, even more than enough.

COUNCIL REPORT

The Faith Lutheran Church Council met Wednesday, June 9, 2021.

Pastor Ron is planning on moving full time to Madison by the 1st of July and will need assistance with the move. He is now able to visit members of Faith Lutheran Church who are in nursing homes and assisted living. He will be gone July 5th through July 11th, but will be here for Norma Larsen's funeral that weekend.

Faith Lutheran Church welcomes Amy Brehmer and Braelyn Brehmer as new members.

The Second Harvest banquet will re-start in June. This meal for those who receive food boxes through Second Harvest was on hold during the pandemic.

Coffee hour is again being offered after Sunday worship. There was discussion on how to get people to sign up to serve. If all members took part, any one family would only need to serve once every year or so.

There was discussion about taping things to the windows and doors. Nothing should be hung without approval of the church office, including on bulletin boards. All posters should be brought to the office for review. Nothing should ever be hung on the doors. Mark Siegert said that doing so damages the doors.

Pastor Ron's contract has been extended to the end of May, 2023.

Faith Lutheran Church is still waiting for the Synod to approve its constitution. Pastor Ron will have Jessica follow up on this.

The church is still in need of an Education Director.

Ryan Giles will discuss with the Properties Committee whether it would be possible to install a basketball hoop somewhere on church property for children's use. The call committee, the synod and the council are all in agreement that Pastor Ron's contract be extended for two years. The call committee will suspend its search for a new pastor until closer to the end of Pastor Ron's contract.

Faith Lutheran Church is still in need of an education director. There was discussion about suggesting that two to three people might consider working together instead of just one person handling the position.

The full minutes of the meeting are posted on the bulletin board across from the office and copies are available in the Church office.


