Last year, 492 households (1054 individuals) were served by the food shelf taking 31,700 # of food plus garden produce donated by area gardeners. All the food purchases are from Second Harvest Heartland in St. Paul which costs us 25 cents on the dollar and from Jubilee in town. Everyone involved with the food shelf is a volunteer.
