Missional Church

Obviously, the Bible teaches us that the right side of the diagram is how we are to understand ourselves. The left side portrays what might be called a more modern view. The left side of the diagram seems to be the most prevalent nowadays.

It's difficult not to get caught up in the modern culture that teaches "bigger is better" and "too much is never enough" mentality. As a result, some churches anxiously pour over attendance records and financial reports convincing themselves that bigger numbers means a job well done. But, is this what Jesus teaches?

I am often reminded of Pr. Lyle Schaller's "M Theory." He states that if your church is mostly concerned with the three M's, "Members, Maintenance, and Money," you have misunderstood the purpose of the church. "Mission" is the first and primary activity of the church. Mission always includes its own members, but must focus attention outward rather than inward. Mission minded churches see the right side of the graphic above as the highest priority.

God never asks us to be a successful church. God always asks us to be a faithful church. As we put mission as the foremost priority of this church, God will continue to bless our every effort.

The Faith Lutheran Church Council met Wednesday, April 14, 2021.

The work that Deb Meyer and Darcie Daline are doing with the Sunday School children is very much appreciated. Joyful Noise will be providing music during a couple of services this spring.

The area church ministerium is planning a cookout and ecumenical worship service on Wednesday, June 2, 2021, with the meal at 5:30 and worship at 6:30. In case of inclement weather, the event will be moved to Wednesday, June 9, 2021. All area churches are invited to participate.

The Discipleship Committee (formerly Lay Ministry) is discussing holding a meet and greet to welcome Pastor Ron. This is still in discussion with more information coming soon.

The funeral policy has been updated to clarify the policies of Faith Lutheran Church.

Faith has many boards and committees with each managing their activities (Alter Guild, Flowers technology, etc.)

WELCA or Women of the ELCA has many church projects including help for funerals and the church fair food fair stand where each confirmed member (men and women) are asked/expected to help. WELCA organizes the event for the church (gets workers, servers, orders supplies, helps with food preparation and disperses the money). Together we get things done.

Money from the stand supports a child from Uganda and one from Sierra Leonne, Green Lake Bible Camp and student camp grants, Little Blessings, Do Day, Bible Study, and church upkeep.

Some of the projects include: kitchen upgrade (counter tops, dishwasher, coffee machine, stoves, kitchen cleaning and, kitchen supplies); Fellowship Hall (painting, lighting, seasonal decorations, new tables and chairs). Money painted the orange outside doors, furnished entry rugs, bathroom and sidewalk upgrades, and \$10,000.00 towards windows, needed things but that are not always in the regular church budget.

According to current guidelines the LqP County Fair Faith food Stand cannot serve food.

However, if allowed, several possibilities have been mentioned.

1. Take out only-stand/church 2. Fundraiser another time 3. Reduced menu




