"Soli Deo Gloria"

Johann Sebastian Bach, a composer who lived about 250 years ago, always wrote at the bottom of his music the initials S.D.G. These initials stood for "Soli Deo Goria" which in the English language means "To God alone be the glory." Bach realized that his music was a gift from God and that he had a responsibility to use his gift to the glory of God.

Bach understood that his music was a gift from God and a gift returned to God. He wrote not for notoriety but for God. In fact, he taught that all that we do in worship is for God and for no one else. This is the essence of worship, to give God alone the glory. Yes, we might like the music or perhaps not like the music, but this is only secondary. Our music in worship is not for the people gathered; it's for God alone! The liturgy is for God; the readings are for God, everything is for God. What we get out of the music and worship is secondary.

My young daughter, one Sunday morning, told me that she wasn't going to worship. She said she didn't get anything out of it. I replied to her that worship's highest goal for those attending is not to get something out of it. It's not designed for an audience of people but is primarily directed to God. God is the only spectator of our worship; we are all participants.

When you attend worship remember your primary reason to be there is to worship God. You might get something out of it. You might like some or all of it, but first you are to give of yourself in prayer and praise. It's all for "God alone be the Glory."

COUNCIL REPORT

The Faith Lutheran Church Council met Wednesday, August 11, 2021.

Pastor Ron reported that Marietta, Nassau, and Louisburg Lutheran Churches are without ministers at this time. They have made arrangements for services and funerals, but asked Pastor Ron if he would be available for emergencies. He also agreed to be emergency backup for Lac qui Parle Lutheran Church, especially during their 151st celebration August 15th due to Pastor Bringle dealing with some health issues.

Confirmation classes are commencing in September. Ninth and tenth graders will be confirmed on Sunday, October 31, 2021.

With COVID increasing, Pastor Ron believes that Faith Lutheran should follow the same guidelines as the local school as well as watching CDC and the State of Minnesota guidelines.

The council is in need of two members as Dave Kriese's and Mark Siegert's terms are ending. A nominating committee is being formed to seek candidates. Elections will be in November with installation in January.

There will be a date set to go through items being stored in various rooms throughout the church. It will be decided whether items need to be kept, can be donated or can be thrown. Boards, such as properties, worship, education, WELCA, as well as Little Blessings will hopefully have representatives at the clean up.

Faith Lutheran has been contacted by a company whose expertise is stained glass windows offering a free analysis of the church's windows. The council decided that it would be a good idea to look at the church windows to see if there is any repair that needs to be done.

The September council meeting will be changed to September 15th due to the Lac qui Parle County Fair being the week of the normal council meeting.

The full minutes of the meeting are posted on the bulletin board across from the office and copies are available in the Church office.



VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL






